Previous experience	<p>Fire risk assessing and report writing</p> <p>Minimum of 5 years' experience of fire risk assessments (plus relevant qualification) for high risk buildings.</p>	Fire Service
Personal qualities	<p>Professional and approachable.</p> <p>Confident in dealing with members of the public and people in a position of authority.</p> <p>Good management of own time/self motivated.</p>
